Big Brothers Big Sisters Hawaii builds and supports one-to-one relationships to ignite the biggest possible futures for youth.

### In the past year, we successfully:

- Enrolled, trained and supported **862** children-in-need and their volunteer mentors
- Held over 20 statewide activities for matches, families and volunteers
- Supported youth through one-to-one mentoring programs resulting in:
  - 96% of youth confident they can say no to drugs, violence and skipping school;
  - 92% of youth confident in completing their school work;
  - 84% of youth having better grades, academic goals and confidence;
  - 94% of youth having a special adult in their life that they can turn to;
  - 95% of youth having a sense of belonging and;
  - 83% of youth planning to graduate high school and college.
- Offered programs and services 100% free to families
- For every dollar donated, **\$0.67** cents were spent directly on supporting our programs. We're only able to serve children who face serious trauma in their lives thanks to our generous donors, caring volunteers, and dedicated board and staff. Thank you all for your continued support.
