



## 2021 Annual Report

Our mission at Big Brothers Big Sisters is to create and support one-to-one mentoring relationships that ignite the power and promise of Hawaii's youth. In the past year, we successfully:

- Offered programs and services 100% free to families
- Served 624 at-risk children, volunteer mentors, and parents
- Responded to over 420 inquiries
- Conducted more than 310 interviews
- Enrolled and matched 208 at-risk youth in one-to-one friendships with mentors
- Facilitated over 2,500 mentoring meetings between pairs in the community
- Supported youth, parental guardians, and mentors with more than 2,400 meetings via phone, email, text, and in-person.
- Held more than 30 virtual and in-person activities for matches, families and volunteers
- Provided additional services to families experiencing hardships due to COVID-19, including care packages, food assistance, support groups, single-parent workshops, financial scholarships, referrals and connections to other health and human service organizations and opportunities for unique activities and experiences offered through our many community partners.
- Supported youth through one-to-one mentoring programs resulting in:
  - 100% improved/maintained of emotional regulation, depressive symptoms, and risky behaviors;
  - 90% reported improved/consistent academic performance and grades;
  - 50% showed greater family/parent connectedness.
